

All spider sizes are head/body length, excluding legs

SIGNS AND SYMPTOMS

SPIDER BITE: Sharp pain • profuse swelling
• nausea, vomiting, diarrhoea.

FUNNEL-WEB SPIDER: Copious saliva • confusion leading to unconsciousness • muscular twitching • breathing difficulty.

1. Check breathing and pulse
2. Calm casualty
3. Apply pressure immobilisation bandage
4. Immobilise casualty
5. Call 000 for an ambulance

RED-BACK SPIDER: Intense pain, spreading • small hairs stand on end.

1. Apply icepack to bitten area and seek medical aid

DEADLY AND DANGEROUS

NOTICE: Male spiders have smaller abdomen, longer legs and swollen palps (for reproduction).

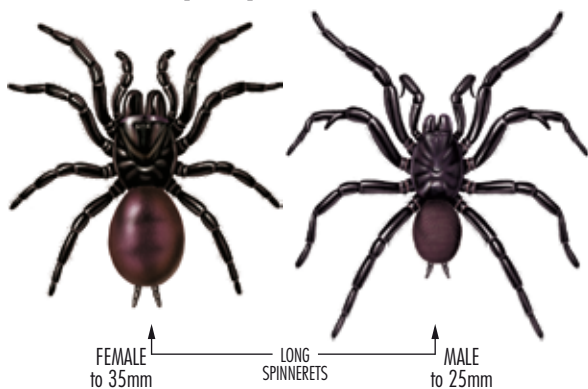

Sydney Funnel-Web



Ground dwelling • aggressive during summer/autumn • one of the world's deadliest spiders

Red-Back



FEMALE to 14mm
MALE to 3mm

Fatal bites recorded
• found under rocks, logs, rubbish, house, etc

White-Tail Spider



FEMALE to 20mm
MALE to 12mm

Bites can result in local ulceration of the skin
• found under bark, rocks, in gardens
• will wander inside home

NOT SO FRIENDLY TOXIC (POISONOUS) – PAINFUL BITE

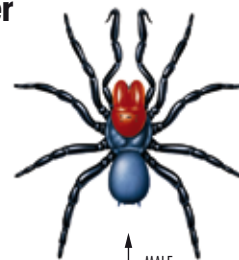
WARNING: Most of these spiders can be dangerous to people with hyper sensitivities or allergies.

Mouse Spider



FEMALE to 20mm

Toxic venom
• deep painful bite
• ground dwelling
• wander after rain
• often mistaken for a funnel-web



SMALL SPINNERETS
MALE to 15mm

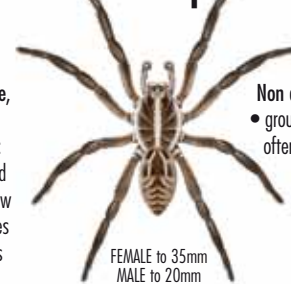
Common Black House Spider



FEMALE to 18mm
MALE to 9mm

Timid
• painful bite, swelling, nausea, etc
• often found around window frames, fences and awnings

Wolf Spider



FEMALE to 35mm
MALE to 20mm

Non aggressive
• ground dwelling often found in lawns

FRIENDLY OR LOW RISK

NOTE: Spiders can be beneficial in control of mosquitoes and flies but if they present a problem – call M&M Pest Management.

Trap-Door



FEMALE to 33mm

Not aggressive • often mistaken for a funnel-web
• ground dwelling (burrow – often without a lid)



SWOLLEN PALPS
MALE to 23mm

Garden Orb-Weaving



FEMALE to 30mm MALE to 20mm

Reluctant to bite • beneficial

• often seen in suspended sticky web in the garden

Saint Andrews Cross



FEMALE to 30mm
MALE to 5mm

Huntsman



FEMALE to 45mm MALE smaller

Timid • seldom bites • found under bark of trees and leaf litter, may wander indoors
